AMBON – BANDA – ALOR - MAUMERE 12 days / 11 nights



Day 01: Ambon - Molana

Arrive in Ambon airport, meet your Guide then transfer to Tulehu port to embark on Mutiara laut. While the cruise director presentation to familiarize the Yacht we will the sail to Molana island. If time allows take your chance to enjoy best coral reef in Molana or just relax on the beach until sunset. In the evening sail toward Banda islands.

Day 02 - 03: Banda island



Today we wake up on the island of Run. Once on land, walk through the historic island, which is blanketed with nutmeg trees. Hundreds of years ago, nutmeg and mace production made Run an important economic resource. After a tour of the island proceed to Nelaka island to do some snorkeling. Late afternoon sail in to the bay of Banda Neira for overnight.



Day second in Banda in the morning, we step into the old town of Banda Neira. Spend the day learning about the fascinating history of this part of Indonesia. Centuries ago, the Dutch used the island as a headquarters to control plantation production. Here, you'll take a tour through ancient fortresses and historic houses. Midday sail to Hatta island for a chance to dive and snorkeling. In the evening sail toward Manuk island.

Day 04: Manuk island

Begin the day on the pristine and remote island of Manuk, where you'll spend time admiring exotic wildlife. Keep your eyes open for rare birds. There's a good chance to spot the frigate birds, gannets and more. In the afternoon, make another crossing to the Nila and Teun island, group of island famous for its active volcano.

Day 05 : Nila – Serua & Teun

Today will be spent visiting the remote volcanic islands of Teun, Serua and Nila. Head to shore and hike through lush jungles. At the end of the journey, prepare to be captivated by an amazing view of the active volcanoes. Coral reef around those volcanic island are very stunning in the depth blue color of Banda sea. After, rest onboard and enjoy on deck cocktail as you sail overnight to Damar.

Day 06: Damar island



In the early morning, visit the exciting island of Danmar. Go ashore and stop at the traditional village of Beber, where you'll admire the impressive huts made from sago palm leaves. In the afternoon, choose to hike around a majestic volcano or travel to the untouched island of Pulau Terbang Utara.

Day 07: Maopora island

Arrive in Moapora and spoil yourself with a beach day on the idyllic island. Grab your snorkels and discover alluring coral gardens and vibrant tropical fish. In the afternoon, make your way to a local village full of ripe orange and coconut groves. Take this opportunity to meet the friendly locals that live on the island and enjoy a cup of sweet tea with them in the afternoon.

Day 08: Wetar island



Wetar is a huge island, measuring 100 km in length, and is registered under Molluca province.. It's is one of the many bordering islands of the country and it has a vague relation to the Timor Leste which can be seen in the south coast. The coast line is covered with lime stone and the island is still known as a volcanic island with some hot spring appears along the beach. Disembark and visit the small settlement on the west part of the island. Just at the front of the village you can do some scuba dive and snorkeling to explore the new coral growing among the black rock that may came from the ancient eruption of this island. The rest of the afternoon lead your way and sail to Alor island.

Day 09: Alor island



Stop in Alor and reach the shores of Kalabahi, the

main town on the island. Enjoy hiking through lush hills and continue until you reach the village of

Takpala. Here, you'll spend the rest of the day experiencing local Indonesian life and learning about their culture. In the late afternoon, return onboard and proceed to nearby island for a scuba dive and snorkeling.

Day 10: Lembata



Arrive on Lembata Island in the morning, and journey to the traditional hunting village of Lamalerap. Here, you'll witness a community whose livelihoods depend entirely on the sea. Fishermen practice whaling in the area and you'll see them busy at work in their tiny sailboats. In the afternoon, take in another beautiful sunset while we cruise towards the Pangabatan island near Maumere.

Day 11: Pangabatang island

December 1992 in Maumere there was a disaster earthquake and killed more than 2000 people. Most of the corals around the island such as Pangabatan, Babi and pulau Besar were destroyed. But ten years later the corals around the area grow back and now it becomes the one of the dive destination in east Flores and even for those who just interested with snorkeling. A small fishing village in Pangabatan is worth to visit with the house are on stilt to avoid the tide. Late afternoon proceed to maumere bay for the night anchor.

Day 12: Disembarkation in Maumere.
